### Friday

**9:30 am. Canada Post Stamp Unveiling and Exhibition Opening.** Representatives from Canada Post in Ottawa will unveil the new marine mammal stamps during the official opening of Royal 2010 Royale.

**10:00 am. Visit Windsor Essex.** For people who want to take a short break from stamps, staff from Tourism Windsor Essex Pelee Island will tell about the attractions of the area.

**12:00 noon. Title Page and Synopsis Seminar.** Tim Bartshe will lead a discussion on the preparation of the two most important pages for your exhibit. What to tell the judges and how to say it.
